


Beautiful floral die cut and embossing techniques


My other interests include gardening, the art of decoupage, watching true life documentaries, reading non fiction and my favorite, which is to follow formula one motor racing.

I would like to thank Kanan for this wonderful opportunity and wish her much success in her crafting journey.




